



OFFICIAL FCI RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIAL ARRANGED BY MÄLARÖ BRUKSHUNDKLUBB MAY 16-17

Mälärö Brukshundklubb warmly welcomes you to an official FCI Rally Obedience international trial in Sweden on **16-17 May 2026**.

This will be the first *official* trial in Sweden conducted in accordance with FCI exercises and regulations, giving competitors the opportunity to obtain the **FCI certificate CACIROB**. (more info below). The results will be registered in the Swedish register Dog Data (Hunddata).

Venue

Mälärö BK is located on Färingsö, Lennartsbergsvägen 8, 179 75 Skå, Sweden.

Schedule

One competition per day with two runs both days.

Saturday, 16 May – assembly at 12:00.

Sunday the 17 May – assembly at 9:00.

The secretary's office opens one hour prior to assembly on both days.

Entry

Swedish handlers must submit entries via **SBK Tävling** no later than 25 April. Please ensure that the dog's height at withers is correctly registered in the system.

Entry fee is 200 SEK per dog/start (the same as Swedish trials).

To register for the competition in SBK Tävling, foreign-owned dogs must be registered and verified in SKK Dog Data (Hunddata).

Please note that if a foreign dog is co-owned by a person living in Sweden, the dog must be re-registered in SKK. The handler of the participating dog must be a member of a club within the SKK organization or in a foreign kennel club recognized by SKK.

Competitors with special needs may compete and are expected to be able to perform the exercises as specified in the regulations, but may have exceptions on special aids, alternative performance of exercises or other exceptions must be sent by email to: tavling@malarobk.se at the time of entry submission.

Practicalities and restrictions

- There is a shortage of water at the venue so please bring water for your dog and yourself.
- There are outdoor toilets (Bajamajor) with stairs of 3 steps.
- The facilities are not properly adapted for disabled/wheelchair users.
 - To access the competition ring you have to cross a sloping grassy area, not recommended for a wheelchair but a short detour has been feasible for a motorized wheelchair.
 - For entering the outdoor toilets one needs to be able to walk up the stairs.
 - There are stairs with a few steps to enter the clubhouse (which is not necessary to compete, one can get help to fetch coffee etc).

Refreshments

Coffee, snacks, and light refreshments will be available for purchase. You can pay with either swish or cash (not creditcards).

Eligibility Requirements

- Champion in the top class of the country, for Sweden it is Master Class Championship.
- Breeds approved according to FCI regulations. <https://fci.be/en/Nomenclature/>
- The dog must have reached a minimum age of 18 months.

Other requirements and regulations

- Only ordinary collars (buckled or with clip) are allowed in the competition ring, choke and half choke collars are not permitted. Tick collars are permitted. For other equipment see the FCI regulations and rules.
- The handler can carry the leash from start to finish, the leash must not be visible during the performance. Alternatively the handler can leave the leash outside the ring.
- Bitches in season are allowed to compete. They will perform at the end of both runs.
- The Swedish Kennel Club National regulations applies and are available in the SKK Show Regulations document (page 5-10 are valid for competitions). This covers vaccinations, identification, behavior, bitches in whelp, neutered dogs, diseases etc. [Show regulations](#)

RALLY OBEDIENCE INTERNATIONAL AWARDS

International FCI Rally Obedience Certificate (FCI CACIROB)

At International FCI Rally Obedience Competitions you can achieve a certificat called FCI CACIROB – Certificat d’Aptitude au Championnat International de Rally Obedience de la FCI),

At International FCI Rally Obedience Competitions only breeds that have already been accepted by the FCI, on a provisional or definitive basis, can take part.

The winning dog (with two testicles, if a male) of the competition is awarded the “FCI CACIROB”, if it earns a final grade of “excellent”.

The second-best dog of the competition (with similar restrictions as above) is awarded the “FCI Reserve CACIROB”, if it earns a final grade of “excellent”.

For these two awards to be confirmed by the FCI, the dogs must be registered with a studbook of an FCI member or contract partner/cooperating partner.

Breeds that have been only accepted by the FCI on a provisional basis or dogs that have been only registered with the appendix (waiting list) of a studbook are allowed to compete but are not eligible for the “FCI CACIROB”/ “FCI Reserve CACIROB”.

Next level - Championship

Requirements for the title FCI International Rally Obedience Champion

To qualify for the title, the following conditions must be fulfilled:

- The dog must be purebred and registered in a studbook or appendix to the studbook recognized by the FCI.
- The dog must have reached the age of at least eighteen (18) months at the time of fulfilling the requirements.
- The dog must have been awarded at least the qualification “**Good**” at an FCI International Dog Show, obtained at a minimum age of fifteen (15) months.
- The dog must have been awarded two (2) CACIROB under two (2) different judges, in two (2) different countries.
- A minimum period of one (1) year and one (1) day must have elapsed between the first and the last CACIROB award.
